PASTOR'S CORNER

Here we are, already in the Sixth Sunday of Easter. Yes, we are still celebrating the Easter Season, and again it is a good time to reflect on where we have come since the Triduum during Holy Week. Holy Thursday began three days of the Triduum liturgy, and we celebrated the Last Supper and Jesus washing the feet of the apostles. This was to remind them that they are called to serve, just as we are all called to serve. Below is a beautiful reflection by Lupe Cabrera on her experience of having her feet washed on Holy Thursday.

"Participating in the washing of the feet really was a powerful experience for me, one I would continue to think about as the days went by. It left a lasting impression on me. I had to put my feelings of embarrassment aside because I knew deep down this would lead me to grow closer to understanding why Jesus would have performed this act of love and the meaning behind it.

Having my feet washed by Father Peter really made me think of Jesus' humility and love for us. Seeing the many different types of people called upon to participate, was a reminder of the love that Jesus had for people from all walks of life. Days after the ceremony I was still thinking of the significance of this act; that Jesus wanted us to know that we are all worthy of his love and forgiveness." Lupe Cabrera



Jesus offers His love to everyone, and we are indeed worthy of that love because he has created us. The apostles were not perfect, and neither are we, but we are all worthy to receive the love of Jesus if we simply open our hearts to that love and let Jesus in.
