On May 4th, we will be doing a clean up project at the Community Center. We will gather at 9:00 a.m. Please join us!



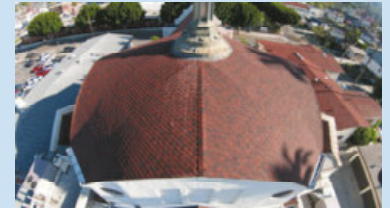
PASTOR'S CORNER

Here is an update of the Called to Renew budget figures. We are in good shape. As of the end of March 2024, at St. Dominic Church here in Eagle Rock:

- Our parish goal was: **\$1,130,000.00.**
- The total pledged by you, our parishioners was a generous sum of: **\$1,797,272.92**
- Total payments by your our parishioners so far: **\$605,275.23.** Half of this is available to St. Dominic's to use: \$302,637.62

Roof repairs have used up more of the Called to Renew funds than we had originally planned. The heavy rains we have had from October though last week have revealed may more leaks than we realized before. We have:

- Replaced the roof on the dome of the church
- Repaired much wood rot and replaced the roof on the convent
- Replaced the roof on the Adult Education Office
- Repaired roof leaks over the elevator of the Community Center
- Repaired roof leaks on Building A of the school.



We still need to repair roof leaks in the parish hall and in one of the bathrooms in the church. Eventually the church roof (not the dome) and the school roof will have to be repaired, but hopefully repairs will last another year or two.

We are planning to repair the sidewalk in front of the church on Merton Ave. The city will be repairing sidewalks around the school and parish hall on Merton Ave., Maywood, and Chickasaw streets.

I want to thank you for your generous payments toward your pledges. We are able to complete these much-needed maintenance projects to protect our property and to keep us all safe, only due to your regular payments to Called to Renew.

Aquí mostramos una actualización de las cifras presupuestarias de Llamados a Renovar. Estamos en buena forma.

A partir de finales de marzo de 2024, en la Iglesia de Santo Domingo aquí en Eagle Rock:

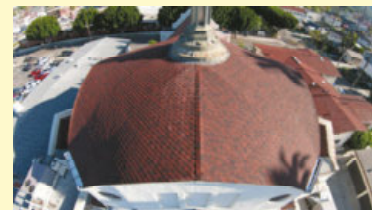
La meta de nuestra parroquia era: **\$1,130,000.00.**

El total prometido por ustedes, nuestros feligreses, fue una generosa suma de: **\$1,797,272.92**

Pagos totales de nuestros feligreses hasta el momento: **\$605,275.23**

Las reparaciones de techos han consumido más fondos de Llamados a Renovar de lo que habíamos planeado originalmente. Las fuertes lluvias que hemos tenido desde octubre hasta la semana pasada han revelado muchas más goteras de las que nos dimos cuenta antes. Hemos hecho lo siguiente:

- Se reemplazó el techo de la cúpula de la iglesia.
- Se reparó mucha podredumbre de la madera y se reemplazó el techo del convento.
- Se reemplazaron las goteras del techo en la Oficina de Educación de Adultos.
- Goteras en el techo reparadas sobre el ascensor del Centro Comunitario.
- Se repararon las goteras del techo en el Edificio A de la escuela.



Todavía tenemos que reparar las goteras del techo en el salón parroquial y en uno de los baños de la iglesia. Eventualmente, el techo de la iglesia (no la cúpula) y el techo de la escuela tendrán que ser reparados, pero esperamos que las reparaciones duren uno o dos años más.

Vamos a reparar la acera frente a la iglesia en Merton Ave. La ciudad reparará las aceras alrededor de la escuela y el salón parroquial en las calles Merton Ave., Maywood y Chickasaw.

Quiero agradecerles por los generosos pagos de sus promesas. Podemos realizar estos proyectos de mantenimiento tan necesarios para proteger nuestra propiedad y mantenernos a todos seguros solamente con la ayuda de sus pagos regulares al proyecto Llamados a Renovar (Called to Renew).
